The documents about account/password, how to activate your account, and so on are here. You are supposed to activate your computer account through this document. We are planning to add some more documents. We would like you to pay attention to this Web page continuously.

You are also expected to pay attention to the following topics.

- ID called SSO-KID (Single Sign-On Kyushu university ID) is supplied to you to use the information systems. Your SSO-KID is on the back of your student identification card, and your registration codes is on the bottom left of the front side.
- If you were an undergraduate or research student at Kyushu University, you can use the same SSO-KID and Password as before.
- Kyushu University will send important notice to Student Primary Mail Address, please check your mailbox frequently.
- Capacity of student primary mail service is 100GB for each user.
- You can use an e-mail address based on your English name and your student ID. Your student ID will be changed when you enter graduate school from undergraduate school or Research student. As a result, your primary e-mail address based on your student ID also changes. However, you can use your e-mail address based on your English name for your student lifelong.
